1. Summary of Important Information

Draft Night: Tuesday July 8th – Closed to the public

Registration Fees: Goalies \$50 / Skaters \$150

Due Date: All payments are due in full before Tuesday July 1st at 7:00pm to be draft eligible

As always, SAH is a "No Pay, No Play" league

Payment Methods: Multiple payment methods are available, see below for details.

PayPal or Venmo to sheboyganadulthockey@yahoo.com are preferred methods

Regular Season: 7 Sundays, 2 Thursdays, and 1 Saturday beginning July 13th

We are expecting to have 4 teams

Adult Hockey Drop-In: See Sheboygan Lakers Ice Center website for details

Referee Pay: \$40 per game per referee using a two-referee system

Referees must pay league fee as normal, referee payout at end of season

Lifetime Waiver: All players must complete this one time and file with the league

2. Registration, Fee Rules, Structure, and Payment Options

The following registration fee structure applies:

- Skaters: \$150
- Goalies: \$50

All players must have their registration fees paid in full before the deadline on Tuesday July 1st at 7:00pm to be draft eligible. Sheboygan Adult Hockey is a "No Pay, No Play" league.

Receipt of your registration fee payment in advance of the draft will serve as your official registration this season.

Here's how registration fees can be kept as low as possible

- Recruit more players to fill rosters
- Recruit more sponsors (All Sponsorships Are Filled)

Roster space is limited to preserve the highest value for paid participants. The draft will establish the final rosters. Rosters spots are subject to commissioner approval. Players register individually, not as a team.

There are multiple methods available to you for making your league registration fee payment. They are listed here in order of preference.

1) *Online – PayPal – Using Bank Transfer or PayPal Balance to eliminate fees on SAH end*

IMPORTANT – read details regarding PayPal fees below before sending money

PayPal payments can be made such that NO FEES are charged to either party involved in the transaction. Any payment made that incurs fees on the SAH end will be rejected. Your payment due will increase accordingly to cover any leftover fees and hassle.

To avoid fees:

- Use the Option to Send to a friend / family (**FREE!**)
- Use a funding source that uses your PayPal balance or Bank Transfer (**FREE!**)
- Avoid using a funding source like Credit Cards and Debit Cards – there will be a fee
- Avoid paying for goods and services – there will be a fee

If asked to pay fees or pass along, pay the fees on your end. DO NOT pass fees on to Sheboygan Adult Hockey.

If you use a debit or credit card (and possibly certain other options) there will be a fee that you will need to pay. If you choose something other than Friend/Family there will be fees incurred on the SAH end.

2) *Online – Venmo – Using Bank Transfer, Debit Card, or Venmo Balance to eliminate fees on SAH end*

- Avoid using a funding source like Credit Cards – there will be a fee

If you use a credit card (and possibly certain other options) there will be a fee that you will need to pay.

3) *Check or Cash*

If not able to use either electronic service listed above, please reach out to us for to discuss cash/check options.

3. Captains, Team Selection/Draft, and Player Notification

Teams are drafted every season by the team captains. Players will be notified by their team captain after the draft has been completed via their email address or phone number on file with the league. The draft process is closed to the public.

Shortly after the draft, the results will be added to the league website's roster page, which can be found under the Team/Stats drop down menu option at the top of the page. There may be a delay in this update as roster spots are reviewed for final approval by the commissioner.

4. Regular Season Schedule Details

After teams are formed, regular season games will begin Sunday July 7th.

Game times will be:

7:00pm and 8:15pm for all events

The season will consist of 10 refereed games (includes 2 playoff games) of three 20-minute run periods.

The season will consist of 7 Sunday night games, 2 Thursday night game, and 1 Saturday night game. Championship Weekend will take place on Saturday August 23rd and Sunday August 24th. (all dates and times subject to change)

Final schedule can be found on the league website and any changes to the schedule will be reflected there as they happen. The website will be your source for the final schedule and any information about it.

5. Team Sponsors and Player Jerseys

Each player will be provided with a jersey at the beginning of the season that they will keep at the end of the season.

6. Refereeing – An Opportunity to Make Some Extra Cash

The paid duty of refereeing games falls on the shoulders of willing league members every season.

Anyone who wants to referee will still need to pay their league registration fees in full, like all other participants, as defined by league rules at the beginning of the season.

No registration fee credit will be given in advance of service provided.

Payment for the number of games refereed will be made based on your preference.

After each week via PayPal or Venmo

--or--

After the season via Check

The pay for refereeing will be \$60 per game using a one referee system or \$40 per referee using a two referee system.

All referees must wear a striped referee jersey, which will be provided. Referees should plan on providing their own whistle. No certifications are required to qualify for this work, currently.

[To Be Determined] will be coordinating the referees this season. Contact information is at the bottom of this letter.

Please notify us as soon as possible at sheboyganadulthockey@yahoo.com if you are interested in helping behind the whistle this season. Knowing the referees by draft night would be very helpful as teams are drafted, to ensure adequate coverage for this duty on a game-by-game basis.

7. Adult Drop-In Hockey

Adult Drop-In hockey scheduling is controlled by the Sheboygan Lakers Ice Center. Check with them or their website to determine when it will be offered.

Note: Drop-In Times, Dates, and Pricing set by Sheboygan Lakers Ice Center and are subject to change. Refer to their website to confirm scheduled events.

8. Lifetime Waiver Requirement

All players are required to have a lifetime waiver on file with the SAH. Once you have filled one out, it will be good while you are a member of the SAH. Please make a copy and keep it for your records. Give the original waiver to Kyle Korpi at the rink. If you need a blank copy, they will be available at the rink during pre-season drop-in as well as the first week of league play.

The lifetime waiver form can be sent to you via email, upon request. It can be found on the SAH Website, as well. It is under the "League" menu option at the top of the site.

9. Insurance Provider

The league's insurance policy this season has been brokered by Beacon Sports Insurance. If you would like more details about this insurance, please contact us.

10. Substitute Player Rules

All substitute players must be registered & paid SAH participants.

Substitute players are only allowed up to a total of 9 skaters when number of the team's rostered players in attendance for a team falls below that number.

All substitute players will be subject to mutual captain agreement for the participating teams.
